Consultation documents Overview & Next Steps

The draft proposal for amendments and corrections to the ITS on Reporting and ITS on Disclosure include only the minimum amendments correcting existing mistakes and improving the understanding of the current requirements, and facilitate the reporting and quality of the information reported.

The reasons for the main proposed amendments/corrections are:

- Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1542 adopted in June 2017 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/35 concerning the calculation of regulatory capital requirements for certain categories of assets held by insurance and reinsurance undertakings (infrastructure corporates);
- Analysis of Variation Analysis templates: the number of questions received on the Variation Analysis templates over the last months have been answered in a structured way which resulted in the publication of EIOPA Explanatory Notes on Variation Analysis templates;
- Other issues identified via the Q&A process and by the NCAs;
- Proposals received from the industry.

Which are the documents for consultation?

This call for comments includes the following documents:

- 1. Draft amendment to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/2450 of 2 December 2015 laying down implementing technical standards with regard to the templates for the submission of information to the supervisory authorities;
- 2. Draft amendment to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/2452 of 2 December 2015 laying down implementing technical standards with regard to the procedures, formats and templates of the solvency and financial condition report;
- 3. Correction to the Guidelines on Financial Stability Reporting in the form of an ERRATA document;
- 4. Set of new validations to be included in XBRL taxonomy version 2.3.0;
- 5. Impact Assessment;
- 6. Template for Comments.

Engagement with stakeholders

In addition to the consultation process, EIOPA is organising a **public event** with stakeholders on the **12**th **of April** where it will explain all corrections and amendments as well as answer any questions on the process and content.

Next steps

EIOPA will consider the responses it receives to this consultation, and will finalise the draft amendments and corrections to the ITS on Reporting, ITS on Disclosure and ERRATA on the Guidelines on reporting for Financial Stability Purposes.

The draft amendments and corrections to the ITS on Reporting and ITS on Disclosure will then be submitted to the European Commission for endorsement.

All corrections and amendments and the new set of validations will be incorporated in the XBRL taxonomy version 2.3.0. which public working draft should be published by 1 June for consultation and final draft published by 15 July, in line with the Governance of Taxonomy Releases.
